## Uniform Reminder

A few reminders regarding our expectations for our boys and girls and their uniform:-

- Long hair should be tied back at all times.
- Haircuts should be neat, presentable and not 'extreme' in style. For example; tramlines, patterned styles and Mohican cuts are not permitted and should be grown out as soon as possible.
- Small, stud earrings are permitted, but must be removed for PE lessons and sports clubs.
- Makeup is not permitted at any time.
- No nail varnish please.
- Shoes need to be watertight and not canvas style trainers.

Milldene is a 'nut free' school and, as such, we cannot allow ANY products to enter the school which contain, or may contain, any nuts.



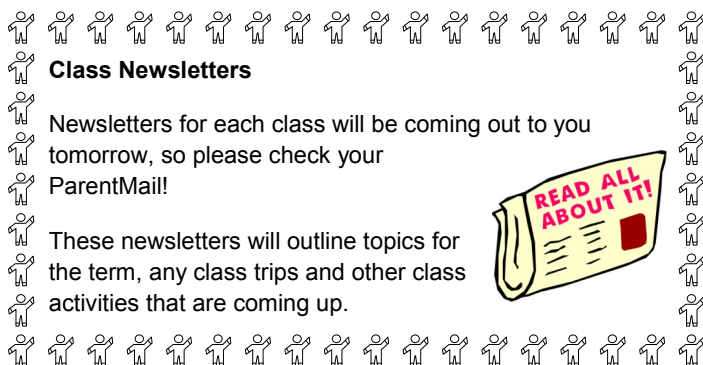

The first Books and Biscuits of the new school year was a great celebration, with carefully presented work evident in all the books the children proudly shared.

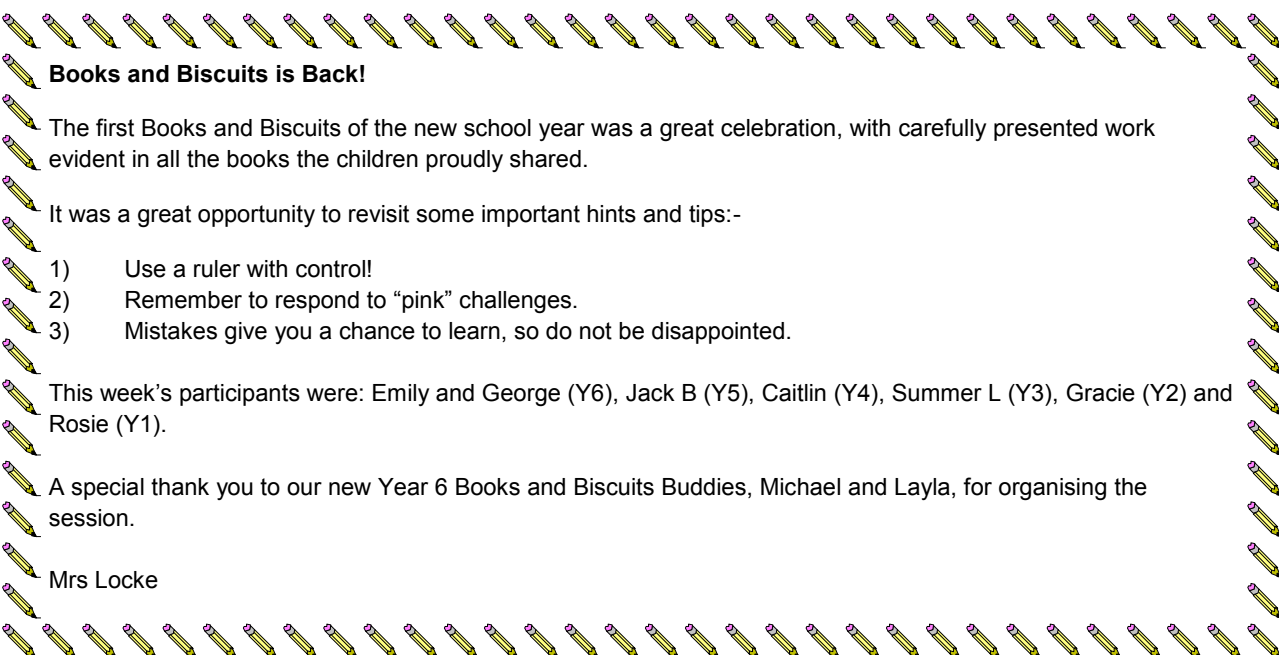
It was a great opportunity to revisit some important hints and tips:-
